On January 23, 2026, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a Certificate of Concurrence¹ to a non-conforming LGIA between TransWest Express LLC, Power Company of Wyoming LLC, and CAISO.² CAISO requested that the Certificate of Concurrence be accepted effective September 2, 2025. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective September 2, 2025, as requested.³

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission’s regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.
