## MOTION TO INTERVENE AND COMMENTS OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION IN RESPONSE TO OFFER OF SETTLEMENT

The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO") submits this motion to intervene and comments<sup>1</sup> supporting the Offer of Settlement (Settlement) filed in this docket by Greenleaf Energy Unit 2, LLC (Greenleaf) on February 26, 2025.

#### I. Motion to Intervene

The Settlement relates to Greenleaf's petition, currently pending before the Commission in Docket No. ER24-785-000, requesting relief from application of the CAISO tariff and the terms of the Reliability Must-Run (RMR) Agreement between Greenleaf and the CAISO. The Settlement revises the RMR Agreement between the CAISO and Greenleaf. As a party to the RMR Agreement and Docket No. ER24-785-000, the CAISO has a direct interest in this proceeding. Because no other party can adequately represent the CAISO's interests in the proceeding, the CAISO's intervention is in the public interest and should be granted.

The CAISO submits these comments pursuant to Rules 212 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.212, 385.214.

### II. Comments

The CAISO, Greenleaf, and the California Public Utilities Commission (Active Parties) spent considerable time engaging in multiple informal settlement discussions regarding Greenleaf's petition. The Settlement accurately reflects the culmination of the Active Parties' settlement discussions and appropriately resolves all of the disputed issues in Docket No. ER24-785-000. Furthermore, approval of the agreement will avoid unnecessary and costly litigation. As a result, Commission acceptance of the Settlement Agreement will have a just and reasonable outcome. The Commission should accept the Settlement as filed.
