Dear Secretary Reese:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) hereby submits for filing a Certificate of Concurrence with respect to the Affected Participating Transmission Owner Upgrade Facilities Agreement (UFA) among Southern California Edison Company (SCE), Olympus Phase 1, LLC, Olympus Phase 2, LLC and Olympus Phase 3, LLC (collectively, Olympus), and the CAISO.<sup>1</sup>

## **I. Overview and Designated Filer**

On May 11, 2023, SCE submitted the UFA in Docket No. ER23-1866-000, with a requested effective date of May 12, 2023. On January 13, 2026, SCE submitted the amended UFA in Docket No. ER26-1026-000, with a requested effective date of January 14, 2026. In that filing, SCE explained that the UFA is non-conforming because the CAISO and SCE do not have *pro forma* UFAs as part of their tariffs. On March 4, 2026, the Commission accepted the UFA via letter order, effective January 14, 2026.

Rather than filing a duplicate version of the UFA under the CAISO tariff, the CAISO is submitting a concurrence tariff record. The concurrence tariff record is designated under the CASO tariff as Service Agreement No. 7750.

SCE serves as the “designated filer” to the UFA pursuant to the Joint Tariff Filing procedures outlined in Order No. 714.<sup>2</sup> SCE filed the service agreement under SCE’s Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) and designated it as Service Agreement No. 300.

## **II. Proposed Effective Date and General Request for Waivers**

Consistent with prior Certificates of Concurrence, the CAISO respectfully requests any waivers of the Commission’s filing regulations necessary to establish an effective date of January 14, 2026, for its Certificate of Concurrence for the UFA. This will give the certificate an effective date consistent with the January 14, 2026, effective date that SCE requested in its January 13, 2026 filing. To the extent that the enclosed materials and information do not meet the detailed filing requirements of the Commission’s regulations, the CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant any necessary waivers.
