**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR REHEARING OF  
THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR  
CORPORATION**

On March 20, 2025, the Commission approved a settlement agreement in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Section 3.3 of the agreement calls for the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) to withdraw its April 8, 2024, request for rehearing within ten days of the agreement's effective date.<sup>2</sup> Because no party filed a protest or comment in opposition to the settlement, per section 4.1 of the settlement agreement, the agreement became effective on March 20, 2025 (*i.e.*, the date of the Commission's order). Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 216 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and
