# MOTION OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION TO WITHDRAW COMPLIANCE FILING

#### I. Introduction

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.212) and the rules for filing rate schedules and tariffs under the Federal Power Act, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (the ISO) submits this motion to withdraw its filing submitted on February 28, 2011 in compliance with the Commission's February 11, 2011 order approving an offer of settlement in Docket No. EL09-62. This compliance filing was inadvertently filed with the eTariff filing code 10 instead of filing code 80. It also appears that no effective date was reflected in the eTariff public viewer. In addition to submitting this motion, the ISO is re-submitting its compliance filing in Docket No. ER11-2973-000.

### II. Good cause exists to allow the ISO to withdraw its compliance filing

The ISO believes good cause exists to allow the ISO to withdraw this compliance filing from Docket ER11-2973-000. First, allowing the ISO to withdraw its filing will help ensure accurate records are kept in the Commission's

databases. Second, allowing the ISO to withdraw its filing will help avoid any confusion among persons who are served with the ISO's compliance filing. For these reasons, the ISO believes good cause exists to authorize the ISO to withdraw its February 28, 2011 compliance filing.

#### III. Conclusion

The Commission should allow the ISO to withdraw its February 28, 2011 filing in Docket No. ER11-2973-000. The ISO is re-submitting its filing with the appropriate filing code (80) and effective date.<sup>2</sup> Granting this motion will ensure more accurate Commission records and avoid unnecessary confusion among persons who have an interest in reviewing and responding to the ISO's compliance filing in Docket No. ER11-2973-000.

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Under the offer of settlement in Docket No. EL09-62 approved by the Commission, the relevant tariff provisions are effective as of March 31, 2009. The earliest effective date that can be reflected in the eTariff system, however, is the date the ISO submitted its baseline tariff in the eTariff system, which was June 28, 2010. Therefore, the metadata for the tariff records submitted with the ISO's compliance filing will reflect a proposed effective date of June 28, 2010. The ISO will also submit "paper" tariff sheets effective March 31, 2009, as an attachment to its compliance filing.
