NOTICE EXTENDING ANSWER PERIOD

(March 4, 2011)

On February 16, 2011, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a motion for an extension of time to further disaggregate the load aggregation points (LAPs) used for scheduling and settling demand in the CAISO default markets as required by the Commission's Order Conditionally Accepting the California Independent System Operator Corporation's Electric Tariff Filing to Reflect Market Redesign and Technology Upgrade issued on September 21, 2006, in the above-referenced proceeding.¹ In its motion, CAISO requests an extension from April 1, 2012, to the last quarter of 2014 to implement greater default LAP disaggregation.

By this notice, the date for filing answers to CAISO's motion is extended to and including March 21, 2011.
