Reference: Informational Filing of Revised Transmission Access Charges

Dear Mr. Dozier:

On March 31, 2009, California System Independent Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted an informational filing regarding the CAISO's revised transmission access charges effective March 1, 2009. The basis for the CAISO's revised transmission access charges is to implement the revised Transmission Revenue Requirements of Pacific Gas & Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company. Receipt of the CAISO's informational filing is acknowledged.

The filing was noticed on April 6, 2009, with comments due on April 22, 2009. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

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This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development – West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
