ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE CONVENING STATUS CONFERENCE

(Issued May 18, 2016)

1. On May 16, 2016, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) filed a status report with the Acting Chief Administrative Law Judge (Chief Judge). The status report was filed in response to the *Order of Chief Judge Continuing Suspension of Proceedings and Ordering Further Status Reports* issued on February 16, 2016. The status reports states that “there have been no occurrences that alter the conclusion reached by the ISO and active parties to this proceeding . . . that the procedural schedule in these proceedings should continue to be suspended pending the outcome of the California refund proceeding.”<sup>1</sup>

2. In light of the lengthy duration of this proceeding which has now spanned more than 14 years,<sup>2</sup> a status conference regarding this proceeding will be convened before the

Chief Judge on June 9, 2016, at 10 a.m., in a hearing room of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, NE, Washington, DC 20426. The decision to continue or terminate the abeyance that is currently in place will be deferred pending the outcome of the status conference and the participants should be prepared to argue why this proceeding should not proceed to hearing immediately.
