On March 27, 2020, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a filing to comply with the directive in the Commission's letter order accepting CAISO's revised Transmission Control Agreement and granting waiver dated February 27, 2020 in Docket No. ER20-692-000.<sup>1</sup> Specifically, the Commission directed CAISO to submit a compliance filing to revise the effective date for the Transmission Control Agreement if the changes associated with Horizon West Transmission (Horizon West) in the event energization of the Horizon West project occurred on a date other than February 28, 2020. On February 29, 2020, Horizon West informed CAISO that the energization of the project occurred on February 29, 2020. CAISO's filing satisfactorily complies with the February 2020 Order, and is accepted for filing, effective February 29, 2020.<sup>2</sup>

This filing was noticed on March 27, 2020, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before April 17, 2020. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and

Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
