

II. BACKGROUND

On January 14, 2004, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) tendered for filing Generator Special Facilities Agreement (GSFA), and Generator Interconnection Agreement (GIA) between PG&E and Mirant Delta, LLC (Mirant), El Dorado Irrigation District (El Dorado), and Midway Sunset Cogeneration Company (Midway Sunset) (collectively, Parties), and Notice of Termination of PG&E Service Agreement No. 51, under FERC Electric Tariff, Sixth Revised Volume No. 5.

By its Notice issued January 21, 2004, the Commission established February 4, 2004 as the date motions to intervene are to be filed in the above-captioned proceeding.


III. BASIS FOR MOTION TO INTERVENE

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
