
**MOTION OF THE
CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
COMPLIANCE FILING DUE ON JANUARY 20, 2004**

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.212 (2003), the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO") submits this motion for an extension of time to submit a compliance filing that is required by the Commission's Order issued on October 22, 2003 in this proceeding.¹ That order required the ISO to submit a compliance filing that corrects inconsistencies and eliminates invalid references in both its Tariff and Operating Protocols.² By this motion, the ISO requests a limited 21-day extension of time so that its compliance filing will be due on February 10, 2004 instead of January 20, 2004


The ISO requests this extension for good cause, that is, because its review of the possible inconsistencies and invalid references in its Tariff and Operating Protocols cannot be completed within the 90-day time frame established by the Commission's order. Thus, the ISO respectfully requests that this motion be granted, and that the due date for the ISO's compliance filing be set for February 10, 2004.

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
