NOTICE OF FILING

(July 10, 2003)

Take notice that on July 7, 2003, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) tendered for filing in compliance with the Commission's Order of May 30, 2003, 103 FERC ¶61,260, (Order) in which the Commission acted on an amendment (Amendment No. 49) to the ISO Tariff. In the Order (at P25), the Commission required that the ISO submit a report identifying the Scheduling Coordinators who are not in compliance with the metering requirement as described in the ISO Tariff, the reasons for the non-compliance, and the anticipated date of compliance.

The ISO states it has served copies of this filing on the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, the California Energy Commission, the California Electricity Oversight Board, the Participating Transmission Owners under the ISO Tariff, all parties with effective Scheduling Coordinator Service Agreements under the ISO Tariff, and to all parties not among the foregoing on the restricted service list. The ISO also states that this filing will be posted on the ISO's Website.

Any person desiring to intervene or to protest this filing should file with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426, in accordance with Rules 211 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.211 and 385.214). Protests will be considered by the Commission in determining the appropriate action to be taken, but will not serve to make protestants parties to the proceeding. Any person wishing to become a party must file a motion to intervene. All such motions or protests should be filed on or before the comment date, and, to the extent applicable, must be served on the applicant and on any other person designated on the official service list. This filing is available for review at the Commission or may be viewed on the Commission's web site at <http://www.ferc.gov>, using the "FERRIS" link. Enter the docket number excluding the last three digits in the docket number field to access the document.
