**Re: California Independent System Operator Corporation –
Filing of Certificate of Concurrence Relating to the Large Generator
Interconnection Agreement Submitted in Docket No. ER25-172-000**

Dear Secretary Reese:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation (“CAISO”) hereby submits for filing a Certificate of Concurrence with respect to the Large Generator Interconnection Agreement among SunZia Transmission, LLC (SunZia), SunZia Wind North, LLC (SunZia Wind North), and the CAISO, (the LGIA).¹

I. Overview and Designated Filer

On October 21, 2024, SunZia submitted the LGIA in Docket No. ER25-172-000, with a requested open-ended effective date because the date on which the LGIA should become effective, *i.e.*, the date on which operational control of the SunZia transmission system will be granted to the CAISO, is unknown. In that filing, SunZia explained that the LGIA includes provisions that do not conform with the CAISO tariff because the LGIA must account for (1) changes associated with implementation of the Subscriber Participating TO model accepted by the Commission² and (2) provisions in the current interconnection agreement.

Rather than filing a duplicate version of the LGIA under the CAISO tariff, the CAISO is submitting a concurrence tariff record. The concurrence tariff record is designated under the CAISO tariff as Service Agreement No. 8430

SunZia serves as the “designated filer” to the LGIA pursuant to the Joint Tariff Filing procedures outlined in Order No. 714.³ SunZia filed the service agreement under SunZia’s Transmission Owner (TO) Tariff, FERC Electric Tariff Volume No. 2 and designated it as Service Agreement No. 4.

II. Proposed Effective Date and General Request for Waivers

The CAISO respectfully requests any waivers of the Commission’s filing regulations necessary to establish an open-ended⁴ effective date for its Certificate of Concurrence for the LGIA, consistent with the open-ended effective date that SunZia requested in its October 21, 2024 filing. To the extent that the enclosed materials and information do not meet the detailed filing requirements of the Commission’s regulations, the CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant any necessary waivers.
