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III. CAISO’S INTEREST

CalPeak’s Vaca Dixon RMR Unit is located within PG&E’s transmission system and is needed to maintain the reliability of the ISO Controlled Grid. As the Control Area operator and as the counter party to the RMR Agreement, the CAISO has a unique interest in any Commission proceeding that affects an RMR Agreement. Accordingly, the CAISO has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding and requests that it be permitted to intervene. Because no other party can adequately represent the CAISO’s interests in this proceeding, the CAISO’s intervention is in the public interest and should be granted.

IV. COMMENTS

Although the CAISO has not received the “as filed” version of CalPeak’s November 18, 2005 submission of corrected rate schedules for the RMR Service Agreement for the Vaca Dixon RMR Unit, the CAISO has discussed the corrections with CalPeak. Assuming the rate sheets contain the agreed-upon corrections, the November 18, 2005 submission resolves the CAISO’s concerns.¹ The CAISO supports CalPeak’s request for a January 1, 2006 effective date.

V. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Intervene and make the CAISO a party in the above-caption proceeding with full rights of participation.
