Reference: Large Generator Interconnection Agreement

Dear Mr. Anders:

On August 21, 2015, California System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted for filing a non-conforming large generator interconnection agreement (LGIA) among itself, Mesquite Solar 2, LLC (Mesquite Solar) and San Diego Gas and Electric Company. The Mesquite Solar LGIA provides for the interconnection of a solar photovoltaic generating facility located in Maricopa, Arizona. You state that the facility will utilize an existing interconnection comprised of two 500 kV generation tie lines between the Hassayampa Switchyard and the Mesquite 230/500 kV Switchyard. Your submittal is accepted for filing, effective October 21, 2015, as requested.

The filing was noticed on August 21, 2015, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 11, 2015. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated

therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
