ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE ADOPTING  
REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND  
EXTENDING TRACK II DATES

(Issued July 25, 2003)

1. On July 24, 2003, counsel for the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) filed an unopposed motion requesting a brief extension of the current procedural schedule in this proceeding. The ISO asserts that the additional time is necessary for the parties to respond to the clarification recently received on the scope of issues appropriately included from the Commission in its Order on Rehearing on Amendment No. 27 issued July 10, 2003, 104 F.E.R.C. \*61,062, and from the Presiding Administrative Law Judge in a prehearing conference on July 16, 2003. The ISO states that the additional time will enable the parties to adapt their testimony to the issues. A revised schedule, agreed upon by the participants and supported by the Presiding Administrative Law Judge, is hereby adopted for use in this proceeding.
