I apologize for the late submittal of the following comment on the ISO's proposed tariff clarification revisions. To be consistent with the definition for FMM Instructed Imbalance Energy, shouldn't the RTD IIE (page 76 of the matrix) definition also include language referencing the EIM Base Schedules? Also, should the term "Energy" be lowercase, as it is in the FMM IIE definition? See below.

"Imbalance Energy" was eliminated from the ISO Tariff as a defined term in the Order No. 764 tariff amendment. The ISO proposes to align the ISO Tariff with that change.

"Imbalance Energy" was eliminated and replaced with more exacting defined terms. This amendment proposes to align this definition with that change.
