- The **FNM DB141** model is being used for the 2027 CRR markets
- We have posted the DB141 RDFID-PSLF mapping to the Market Participant Portal (MPP) under the following path:

CRR_FNM > 2027_00_Annual

- PSLF Name will be added to the CRR model data within the CRR MUI following an update planned for Q4 2026

SEQ Updates - Load Migration

- 2027 Annual Allocation SEQ Update
 - Monthly Load Migration outcomes will be incorporated into the T1/LT/T2/T3 SEQ on an ongoing basis
 - T1 SEQ recalculation after 8/21 Load Migration Results Posting
 - Previously the Load Migration adjustments to SEQ were not updated after T1 due to system/process limitation
