CRR Production Updates

- Global Derate applied to Emergency Ratings beginning with March 2026 CRR Markets
 - 82.5%, consistent with current process for Normal Rating
 - DAM binding on contingency-based constraints has significantly increased since the time the CRR Global Derate was initially implemented
 - Goal to improve CRR Revenue Adequacy
- 2027 Annual Allocation T2/T3 SEQ Update
 - Monthly Load Migration outcomes will be incorporated into the T2/T3 SEQ in an ongoing basis
 - Previously the Load Migration adjustments to SEQ were not updated after T1 due to system/process limitations
- RDFID-PSLF Mapping File
 - Continue to post to the Market Participant Portal (MPP) until long-term solution in place
 - PSLF Name to be added to Lines and Transformer data at a future date
- CRR Allocation Nomination and Auction Bidding Window Extensions/Re-Opening
 - Extending/Re-opening only due to CAISO technical issues
