Pre-Simulation Market Timeline

- Market Simulation will be end-to-end, including:
 - Registration – location submission, approvals, Resource ID assignment and configuration
 - Bidding – submitting bids to SIBR for optimization
 - Awards – retrieving awards and dispatches from CMRI and ADS
 - Metering – submitting meter data to the DR Application System
 - Settlements – retrieving settlements and shadow settlement
- Due to the Registration timeline, the ISO is proposing to provide two sample Resource IDs to participants interested in beginning bid-to-bill testing on March 1

Pre-Simulation Market Timeline

- Steps to Obtain a Sample Resource ID
 - Jan 11, 2010 – complete the AARF to obtain certificates
 - Feb 4, 2010 – request sample Resource IDs by email
 - Feb 18, 2010 – receive sample Resource IDs / Registrations
 - Feb 25, 2010 – submit sample meter data (if desired)
 - Mar 1, 2010 – begin bid-to-bill simulation
- Sample Resource ID Characteristics
 - ISO will create underlying Locations and Registrations for sample Resources
 - No LSE / UDC approvals will be necessary
 - Resources and Registrations will terminate prior to Go-Live
 - ISO will create historical meter data if none is provided
