On behalf of the California State Council of Laborers, I am writing to respectfully request that the CAISO approve the inclusion of the AV Clearview Transmission Project into the CAISO 2012-2013 Transmission Planning process. This project is being developed by the High Desert Power Authority, a Joint Powers Authority partnership between the Cities of Pittsburg and Lancaster municipal utilities with support from Kern County and Edwards Air Force base.

The AV Clearview Transmission Project is a great example of sound environmental planning and was fully vetted through 4-years of collaboration with local stake holders and permitting agencies. The project benefits include:
