Reliability Coordinator Base Schedule Aggregation Portal (RC BSAP) Upgrade

- RC-BSAP Upgrade to latest version of WebSDK 3.5
 - No significant changes to overall functionality or processes
 - *Banner color change for Production*
 - *Support model – Internet Explorer*
 - *Compatibility settings*
 - Improved Apply/Reset button visibility
 - New button to submit base schedules
 - Updated copy / paste functionality
- Changes are currently available for view in MAP Stage
- Production changes become visible **Tuesday, March 16, 2021**








Update Impacts Apply/Reset Button Visibility

In the new version, the Apply and Reset buttons will now float to always show when you resize your display.




Wider view


Internet Explorer is the browser supported by the CAISO

Basic Display Layout


Note for IE11 Users, all compatibility features must be turned off in order for the displays to function properly.

- Remove any URL and deselect all options.


