Dear Mr. Spomer:

On July 17, 2015, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted tariff revisions to comply with a Commission order issued on May 18, 2015.<sup>1</sup> CAISO states that the tariff revisions indicate that the Commission has granted waiver of specific standards of the Version 003 Standards for Business Practices and Communication Protocols for Public Utilities adopted by the Wholesale Electric Quadrant of the North American Energy Standards Board, and include a cite to the May 18 Order, which granted waiver of the standards. CAISO's revisions satisfactorily comply with the May 18 Order, and are accepted for filing, effective May 15, 2015, as requested.

This filing was noticed on July 20, 2015, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before August 7, 2015. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
