On April 14, 2022, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted, in compliance with the March 2022 Order,<sup>1</sup> revisions to remove the parameter change procedure from the tariff.<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2021), the submittal is accepted for filing, effective August 4, 2021, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed, with interventions and protests due on or before May 5, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2021)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting a late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.
