Dear Mr. Ulmer:

On June 23, 2016, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a filing to comply with the Commission's directives in its June 2 Order.<sup>1</sup> CAISO has revised its tariff to include: (1) language stating that CAISO will impose uninstructed imbalance energy charges on a Distributed Energy Resource Provider who fails to follow a dispatch instruction; and (2) its pricing methodology for both single and multiple node aggregations. Please be advised that your submittal satisfactorily complies with the June 2 Order, and is therefore accepted for filing, effective June 3, 2016, consistent with the effective date granted in the June 2 Order.

The filing was noticed on June 23, 2016, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before July 14, 2016. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
