ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE ACCEPTING LATE-FILED
STATUS REPORT, CONTINUING SUSPENSION
OF PROCEEDINGS AND ORDERING FURTHER STATUS REPORTS

(Issued September 10, 2009)

1. On September 9, 2009, counsel for the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO), filed a *Motion to File Status Report Out of Time and Status Report*. The CAISO states that no party will be prejudiced by accepting the status report out of time because there has been no changes that would result in the re-institution of the procedural schedule herein.
2. The CAISO reports that there have been no occurrences since the filing of the CAISO's last status report in these dockets on May 26, 2009 that would alter the reasons for the Chief Judge's conclusion in his December 12, 2008 Order that the procedural schedule in this case should be suspended pending a Commission order establishing the final balances of the of the entities that participated in markets operated by the CAISO during the Refund Period.
3. For good cause shown, the CAISO's status report is hereby accepted out of time. The procedural schedule in these proceedings will continue in suspension until the Commission issues an order in Docket No. EL00-95-045, *et al.* that establishes the final balances of the entities that participated in the markets operated by the CAISO during the

Refund Period. The CAISO shall file further status reports every 90 days. The CAISO shall provide the Chief Judge with an electronic copy of all status reports at curtis.wagner@ferc.gov.
