The subject areas upon which CAISO seeks stakeholder input are:

- 1. Which of the options listed in the whitepaper as a potential change to the structure of the Market Usage Forward Energy GMC Charge Code do you support?
- 2. <u>If none of the options presented in the whitepaper are supported, do you have an alternative proposal?</u>

Shell Energy supports Option #2. We believe that this option more accurately reflects GMC charges incurred and divides the costs more equitably amongst all SC's. Option #1 does not produce an accurate charge based on an SC's true impact on GMC costs, since gross volume is not considered. For example, a company that schedules a very large amount of mw's onto the grid may end up paying significantly less GMC's than a small company that has a much more minimal impact on ISO management costs. Conversely, option #2 will assign GMC costs based on the true magnitude of an SC's impact on forward scheduling and market usage costs.
