**COMMENTS OF THE CITIES OF ANAHEIM, AZUSA, BANNING, COLTON,  
PASADENA, AND RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA ON THE  
2019 POLICY INITIATIVES CATALOG AND ROADMAP**

In response to the CAISO's request, the Cities of Anaheim, Azusa, Banning, Colton, Pasadena, and Riverside, California (collectively, the "Six Cities") provide their comments on the 2019 Policy Initiatives Catalog and Roadmap.

At this time, the Six Cities limit their comments to the proposed initiative for consideration of whether to sunset the current practice of providing reimbursement for network upgrades described at Section 6.4 of the Policy Initiatives Catalog. The Six Cities have previously suggested that the CAISO consider eliminating the practice of providing reimbursement for network upgrade costs. In light of the apparent over-subscription of the interconnection queue, the Six Cities continue to strongly support consideration of this issue as proposed by PG&E.
