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## STAGE THRE EMERGENCY EXTENDED THROUGH MIDNIGHT TUESDAY New Media Access Information Provided

(Folsom, CA) The California Independent System Operator (California ISO) plans to extend its longestrunning Stage Three Electrical Emergency into a fourth day, Tuesday, January 23, 2001, until midnight. While the total number of power plant units off line due to planned and unplanned outages is down to 7,600 megawatts, much of the generation that is off line is located in the Northern California—leaving that portion of the state vulnerable to the risk of rotating blackouts. **The California ISO does not anticipate initiating rotating** 

## blackouts tonight unless there is a major change in conditions.

To consolidate requests for information from the media, the ISO will hold a telephone-only update tomorrow morning at 7:30 a.m. Formal news teleconference calls will be held this week only if conditions worsen and rotating blackouts are forecasted.
